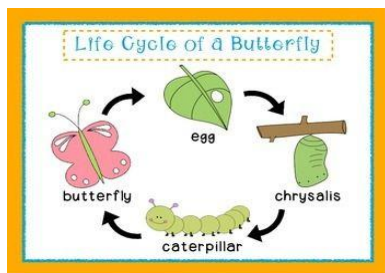

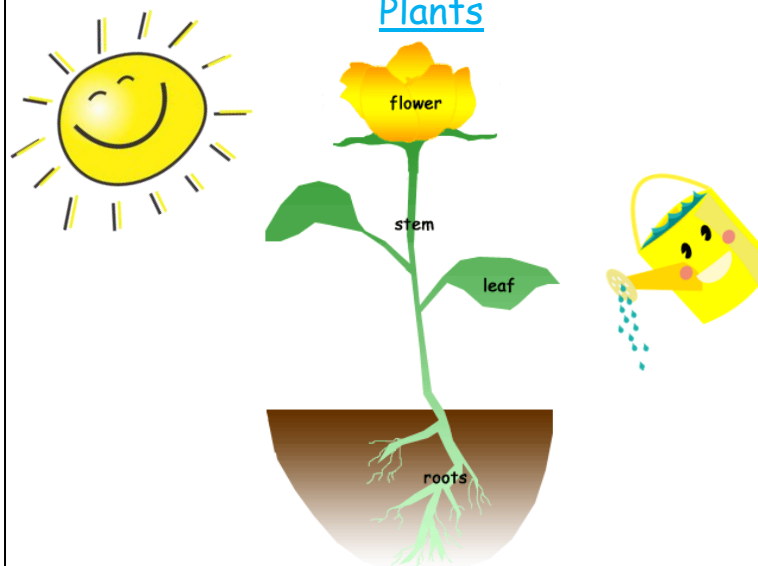

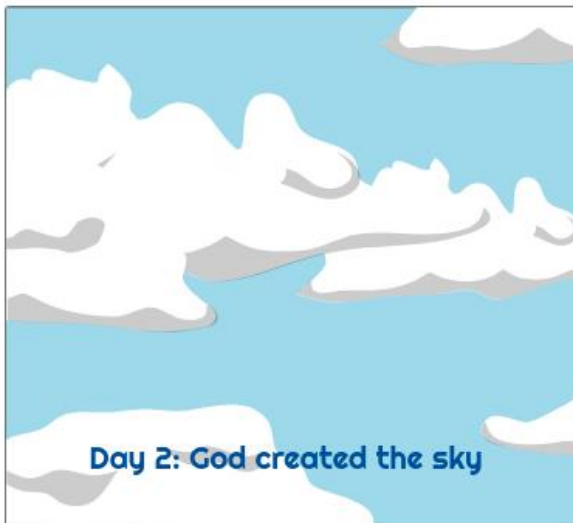
How did God create the world?

Day 2: God created the sky



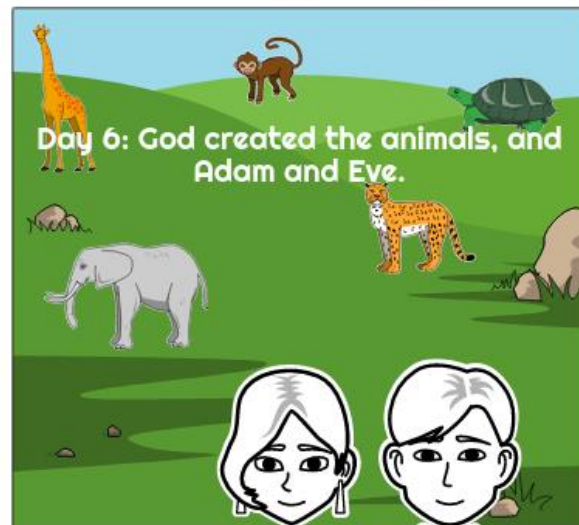
Day 3: God made the land, the seas and rivers, the trees and the plants.
