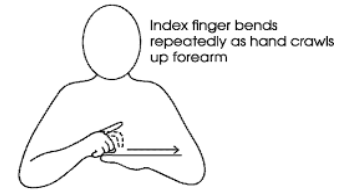


Sticky Knowledge Organiser 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar'

He will eat the leaves around him till he's full, munch, munch. X2

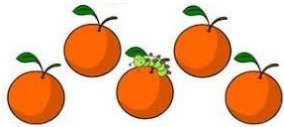

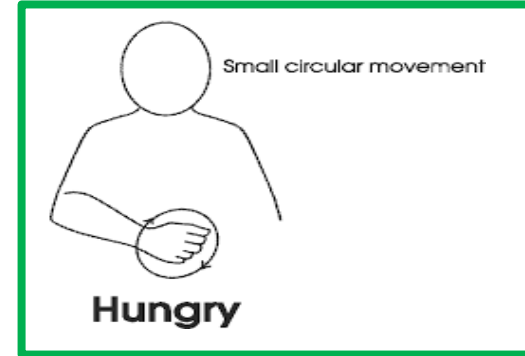

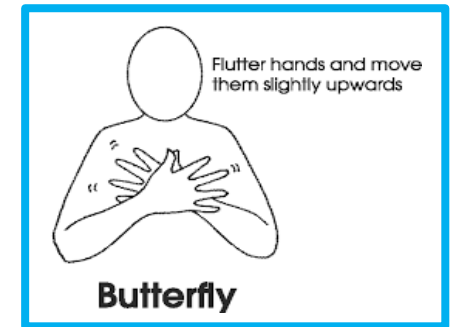
